This letter explains why we need to ask for your consent to any photographs or videos that may be taken of your child while he or she is at Bracknell Ice Hockey Club. When you have read it, please complete and return the form overleaf.

Generally, photographs of children for internet use, and occasionally for publication in the local Press, are a source of pleasure, pride and publicity and so are to be welcomed.

With regards to video footage – this may be used for development of players and teams during the season.

However, we live in an age in which technology has vastly increased the use, and potential misuse, of photographs/footage.

With regard to the Press, the club **will** allow local newspapers to take photographs of children, when appropriate, provided that parental consent has been given.
